



On December 8th, 1982, Ken Schiller was hired as a police officer for the City of Colton Police Department after three years as a Culver City Police Officer. During the Viet Nam war, Detective Schiller was a military police officer for the United States Army. During his career at the Colton Police Department, Detective Schiller was assigned to the Narcotic Unit and the DEA narcotics task force. During these assignments he investigated hundreds of drug cases and clandestine labs. While conducting these investigations, he was exposed to many dangerous chemicals which are known to cause cancer. Detective Schiller became ill and was diagnosed with cancer whereupon he died from his illness on December 28th, 2002. His death was ruled job related and Detective Schiller was inducted into the National Police Memorial in Washington D.C.
