

## REMEMBER ON COLLECTION DAY

- 1 The carts should be placed at the curbside no later than 6:30 am on collection day and removed from the curbside within 12 hours after service.
- 2 The carts should be placed with the handles and wheels facing towards your home.
- 3 Place carts side-by-side approximately 1 foot apart & at least 3 feet from any obstruction (i. e. vehicles, fire hydrants, trees).
- 4 Items placed outside of carts will not be collected. Cart lids should be closed. Please do not overload.

## TEMPORARY COLLECTIONS

Larger waste collection containers (from 3 yards to 40 yards) are available for clean-up projects and other disposal needs. For additional pricing details or to arrange for a delivery of a larger container to your residence or business, please call CR&R Customer Service.



## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household Hazardous Wastes (HHW) are products that are flammable, corrosive, reactive or toxic. They are dangerous to the public and the environment.

## EXAMPLES OF HHW INCLUDE:

- Paint, paint thinner and turpentine
- Cleaners with acid or lye
- Gasoline and antifreeze
- Pesticides and herbicides
- Glues and degreasers
- Car batteries
- Pool chemicals

HHW is not permitted in any of your residential carts. These household hazardous items are accepted at the San Bernardino County Fire Department, Household Hazardous Waste Division, 2824 East "W" Street, Bldg. 302, San Bernardino CA, 92415 1-800-OILY CAT (645-9228)

## BULKY ITEMS

Items that cannot fit in your automated carts are considered bulky items. Bulky items must be manageable by a two-person crew.

## EXAMPLES OF BULKY ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Couches
- Desks
- Chairs
- Tables
- Mattresses
- Excess Green Waste

Residents of Colton, who have the 3-cart trash, recycle and green waste service, will have four (4) free bulky item pick ups per calendar year at their own convenience. Residents must call to schedule the pick up at (909) 370-3377. Some restrictions apply.

## WHITE GOODS HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES

White Goods, or household appliances containing Freon are picked up similar to a bulky item. Refrigerators contain Freon and other chemicals that require special handling. CR&R will collect bulky items and white goods from your curbside.

## E-WASTE

Electronic Waste (e-waste) is anything with a circuit board or battery. It is illegal to dispose of e-waste in any of your automated carts. CR&R will collect and legally dispose of and recycle these items.

## EXAMPLES OF E-WASTE INCLUDE:

- Monitors
- Cell Phones
- Computers
- Televisions
- Microwaves
- Printers

Home generated sharps disposal is available for FREE at the following locations:  
 Hutton Center 660 Colton Avenue Monday-Friday, 8:00 am-2:00 pm.  
 Luque Center 292 East O street Monday-Friday, 10:00 am-1 :00 pm. Items must be in a 1 (one) gallon puncture proof container or smaller.  
 The County of San Bernardino Fire Department , Household Hazardous Waste Division will also accept sharps/needles in approved containers. For info, call 1.800.OILY.CAT (645.9228).

## HOLIDAY SCHEDULE OF NON-COLLECTION DAYS

New Year's Day	Labor Day
Memorial Day	Thanksgiving Day
Fourth of July	Christmas Day

If the Holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, trash will be collected on your normal collection day with no delays to your pickup.

If the Holiday falls during the work week, collection for the remainder of the week will be delayed by one day. For example, if the 4th of July falls on a Monday, and your normal collection day is on Thursday, your pickup for that week will be on Friday.



CR&R provides a Christmas tree collection for a two week period following the holiday season. The following guidelines are for residential curbside collection of Christmas trees:

- Please remove all ornaments, tinsel, lights and stands.
- Do not place trees in plastic bags.
- Place tree in your green waste cart or beside your carts for collection.
- Trees 6 feet or taller must be cut in half.

Palm fronds are not recyclable. Please place cut palm fronds in the trash cart.
